

## GEOPHYSICAL OR SEISMIC SURVEY REQUIREMENTS

The following is a list of requirements before a permit can be issued for geophysical or seismic survey requests:

1. Letter of request
2. Plat showing the line(s) for which the company is requesting a permit
3. \$500,000 Certificate of Insurance (liability insurance)
4. \$50.00 **per line** administration service fee
5. A permit is issued with the stipulation that permission is obtained from **ALL** affected and/or adjacent property owners and the Parish is held harmless from any claims or damages resulting from said work, and further, that no holes are shot within parish right-of-way that are within 500 feet of a residence. Note that in many cases, the mineral rights of road rights-of-way are retained by the original property owners. The applicant should produce an affidavit to confirm the consent of abutting property owners, renters and mineral holders when seismic work is performed within a Parish right-of-way.
6. No seismic work shall be conducted within four feet (4') of the traveled roadway on hardsurfaced roads. Vibroseis equipment may be used within Parish rights-of-way if the road is a gravel road or the work is done 4 feet or more from the traveled roadway.
7. Signing for warning and protection of traffic shall be in accordance with the requirements contained in the latest edition of the Louisiana Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
