ORDINANCE NO. 3020

AN ORDINANCE amending Chapter 15, Licenses and Miscellaneous Business Regulations, of the Code of Ordinances of the Parish of Calcasieu, Louisiana, by adding an article thereto to allow the Police Jury to impose fees or charges on owners or operators of hazardous materials facilities, in accordance with Louisiana Revised Statute 30:1150.68(D).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE POLICE JURY OF CALCASIEU PARISH, LOUISIANA, convened in regular session on the 3rd day of November, 1988, that it does hereby amend Chapter 15, Licenses and Miscellaneous Business Regulations, of the Code of Ordinances of the Parish of Calcasieu, Louisiana, by adding an article thereto, as follows:

Art. VIII. Hazardous Materials Facilities.

Sec. 15-261. Imposition of fees or charges.

The Police Jury shall impose fees or charges on owners or operators of hazardous materials facilities which are located within the parish and who are subject to the reporting requirements of the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986, Title III, Section 312.

Sec. 15-262. Amount of fees or charges.

The amount of the fee or charge imposed pursuant to this article shall provide anticipated proceeds not to exceed the anticipated cost for performing the services required in this article, and the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986, Title III, Section 312, including those initial costs necessary to establish a system for storage, updating, and dissemination of the information herein required to be made available to the public. In no case shall the fees or charges imposed on any one person by the Police Jury exceed one dollar per page, fifty dollars per survey form, or three hundred dollars per report, including, but not limited to, reporting multiple facilities in the parish. In no case shall charges imposed on a small business exceed fifteen dollars per survey form. For the purpose of this article, a small business shall mean a single business establishment employing a maximum of nine employees and showing a maximum of two million dollars in average annual gross receipts.

Sec. 15-263. Collection of fees or charges.

The Calcasieu Parish Local Emergency Planning Committee (CPLEPC) shall collect and administer the fees or charges as set out in Sec. 15-261.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the provisions of this ordinance shall be included and incorporated in the Code of Ordinances of the Parish of Calcasieu, Louisiana, as an addition thereto, and shall be appropriately renumbered to conform to the uniform numbering system of the Code.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any ordinance or parts of any ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall become effective immediately.
